Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No. 5 of 2011 of the Supply Chain Management Policy of Mopani TVET College will apply in the adjudication process. The evaluation of the acceptable bid will be conducted in the following two stages:

- Firstly, the assessment of the administrative criteria and mandatory criteria i.e., compliance criteria. A bidder who does not meet all the compliance criteria will not be assessed further and will be disqualified.
- Secondly, the assessment of functionality will be done in terms of the evaluation criteria. A bidder who scores less than <u>required points for</u> <u>functionality will be regarded as a non-responsive bid and will be disqualified</u>.
- The 80/20 Preferential Point System will apply for this tender.

Preferential Points will be awarded to a Tenderer for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contributor in accordance with the (80/20 Systems)

Tenderers who are listed in the National Treasury register of defaulters will automatically be disqualified. It is compulsory to complete all the documents in full and attach all mandatory required documents. Failure to complete the documents in full and submit mandatory documents will result in Bidders being disqualified.
